Manual Permit Application Review

DURATION OF PERMITS

PERMIT VALID FOR

A single trip permit is valid for one movement up to 3 days.

For a self-propelled fixed vehicle, a single trip permit is valid for multiple movements made within one 24-hour period or a 1-way movement mad within a 3-day period.

REASONABLE ACCESS

ASSIGNED PERMITTED ROUTE

SPEED LIMITS

GENERAL SPEED LIMITS

40 mph when exceeding 5,000 lbs. over legal weight on an axle grouping or when gross weight of 120,000 lbs. off of the interstate.

PERMIT TYPES

SINGLE TRIP PERMITS

Single Trip

ANNUAL

- 1. Seasonal For hay movers, hay grinders, and fertilizer spreaders, grain cleaners, agricultural chemical applicators, forage harvester.
- Overwidth For overwidth vehicle and non-divisible load movements up to 14'6"
- Overlength For overlength vehicle and non-divisible load movements up to 120'



- 4. Interstate For divisible load movements over 80,000 lbs. GVW, not to exceed 105,500 lbs. GVW.
- 5. 129,000 Primary Network for divisible loads on limited highways. All axle weights must be legal, and you must bridge your weight. Maximum weight allowed is 129,000 lbs.

TIMES OF TRAVEL

HOURS OF OPERATION

- 1. Permitted movements <u>not exceeding</u> 16' in width may travel on any day, 1/2 hour before sunrise to 1/2 hour after sunset.
- 2. Permitted movements that are overheight and/or overlength only, may travel on any day, 1/2 hour before sunrise to 1/2 hour after sunset.
- 3. Permitted movements that are 10' in width or less, 120' long or less, or overweight only may travel on any day or night with proper lighting.

HOLIDAYS

Holidays	Permit Office Closed	Load Movement
Christmas Day	December 25, 2020	Permitted movements <u>exceeding</u> 16' in width, <u>may not</u> travel from noon on December 24 until 1/2 hour before sunrise on December 26.
New Year's Day	January 1, 2021	Permitted movements <u>exceeding</u> 16' in width, <u>may not</u> travel from noon on December 31 until sunrise on January 2.
Martin Luther King Day	January 18, 2021	Permitted vehicles and load movements are allowed to travel as stipulated.
President's Day	February 15, 2021	Permitted vehicles and load movements are allowed to travel as stipulated.
Good Friday	April 2, 2021	Permitted vehicles and load movements are allowed to travel as stipulated.
Memorial Day	May 31, 2021	Permitted movements <u>exceeding</u> 16' in width, <u>may not</u> travel from noon on May 29 until sunrise on June 1.
Independence Day	July 4, 2021 July 5, 2021	Permitted movements <u>exceeding</u> 16' in width, <u>may not</u> travel from noon on July 3 until 1/2 hour before sunrise on July 5.
Labor Day	September 6, 2021	Permitted movements <u>exceeding</u> 16' in width, <u>may not</u> travel from noon on September 4 until sunrise on September 7.
Veteran's Day	November 11, 2021	Permitted vehicles and load movements are allowed to travel as stipulated.
Thanksgiving Day	November 25, 2021	Permitted movements <u>exceeding</u> 16' in width, <u>may not</u> travel from noon on November 24 until sunrise on November 26.
Christmas Day	December 24, 2021 December 25, 2021	Permitted movements <u>exceeding</u> 16' in width, <u>may not</u> travel from noon on December 24 until sunrise on December 27.



New Year's Day

December 31, 2021

January 1, 2022

Permitted movements <u>exceeding</u> 16' in width, <u>may not</u> travel from noon on December 31 until sunrise on January 3.

ADVERSE WEATHER

Single trip permits shall not authorize movements when inclement weather prevails, highways are slippery, or when visibility is poor.

PERMIT RESTRICTIONS

Routes of travel are restricted by the <u>Permit Bridge Load Limitations Map</u>, <u>Weight Limitations Map</u>, and the NDDOT <u>Travel Information Map</u>. The travel information map shows road construction, load restrictions, road closures, and road conditions. Routes of travel are also restricted by vertical structures over the highway system.

North Dakota does maintain Spring Thaw Restrictions: see NDHP Motor Carrier Operations.

Studded tires are permitted in North Dakota from October 15 to April 15. There is no mandatory chain law in North Dakota.

Overweight permits are not valid for movement on bituminous pavements [asphalt] when the atmospheric temperature is 90 degrees Fahrenheit or above or when otherwise deemed necessary by the North Dakota Department of Transportation.

BEFORE YOU ORDER

PERMIT INFORMATION REQUIRED

Tractor information; axle configuration on tractor and trailer; load description; net weight, gross weight; axle weights; axle spacing; tire sizes; track width, overall dimensions; load dimensions, origin and destination; routes to be traveled (optional); and effective start date. Require schematic showing track-widths for special mobile equipment and when track width on trailer exceeds normal 8'6".

The online system (E-Permits) (www.nd.gov/ndhp/motor-carrier/e-permits) accepts single trip permit applications for all oversize/overweight vehicles or loads movements. Axle weights shall not exceed maximum permitted limits. See the Permit Policy for Movement of Oversize and Overweight Vehicles and/or Loads for further information, www.nd.gov/ndhp, click on Motor Carrier, then Permit Policies.

Permit requests with specialized trailers that exceed the online axle weights may complete the Application for Single Trip Permit for Excessive Size and Weight (SFN 59716) then submit to ndhppermits@nd.gov or contact the Permits Section at (701) 328-2621.

Divisible load permits are available for loads up to 10' in width, and on the interstate for over 80,000 lbs. GVW not to exceed 105,500 lbs. GVW.

A legible electronic or paper copy of a permit must be carried in the vehicle at the time of the movement.

Authorized nighttime movements shall be lighted with clearance lights mounted on the extreme outer width and visible from the front and rear at a distance of 500'.

Insurance: Proof of insurance must be on file with the Motor Carrier Permit Section when moving a manufactured housing unit, or when applying for a seasonal permit. Liability coverage shall be



no less than \$100,000 per person, \$300,000 per accident, and \$50,000 property damage; \$300,000 liability and property damage, respectively.

Single Trip for Oversize & Overweight: Routine = \$20 plus \$10 service/routing fee

Non-divisible Overwidth Annual Permit: \$150

Non-divisible Overlength Annual Permit: \$150

Divisible Load Single Trip: \$10 or \$20, plus \$10 service/routing fee

Divisible Load Annual Interstate Permit: \$300

Special Mobile Equipment Single Trip: \$25 plus \$10 service/routing fee

Workover Service Rig Single Trip: \$100 plus \$10 service/routing fee

Seasonal (annual): \$50

Permit Fees on vehicles/loads with a GVW greater than 150,000 lbs.

A \$0.05 ton/mile fee is assessed upon that portion of gross vehicle weight exceeding 200,000 lbs.

ENGINEERING ANALYSIS COST

<u>FLAGS, LIGHTS, SIGNS</u>

FLAGS

Flags displayed on the traffic side front and rear must be 18" square and either red or bright orange in color.

LIGHTS

Authorized nighttime movements shall be lighted with clearance lights mounted on the extreme outer width and visible from the front and rear at a distance of 500'.

SIGNS

Oversize load signs must have dimensions of at least 12" x 60" and have a yellow background with black letters at least 8" high and with a 1" brush stroke. Vehicles over 75' in length or 8'6" in width must have an "OVERSIZE LOAD" sign on front and rear.

When the movement is overlength only, exceeding 75', a 12" x 60" "LONG LOAD" sign may be used. Letters must be at least 8" in height with 1" brush stroke.



ESCORTS/PILOT CAR

PILOT CAR REQUIRED WHEN

	# of escorts required
Width > 14'6" > 16'	1
	May be equipped w/lighted rotating/flashing amber light visible from front and rear at 500' in lieu of a pilot car on a 2-lane if <16'.
Width > 16'	Front and rear pilot cars on a 2-lane
Width ≥ 16'	1 rear pilot car on a 4-lane
Width > 18'	NDHP escort
Height > 18'	Minimum of 1 lead
Length > 120'	1 Rear

Excessive overweight load movements are also subject to pilot cars and an official escort.

PILOT CAR CERTIFICATION

Pilot Car Escort Certification is not currently required.

PILOT CAR REQUIREMENTS

- Must be passenger vehicle of 2-axle truck only.
- Driver must have a driver's license and be 18 years of age or older.
- Must be radio communication between the pilot car(s) and vehicle being escorted.
- Must have highest point of vehicle marked with a sign that is a minimum of 12" x 60" with the words "OVERSIZE LOAD".
- Flashing amber lights must be mounted on both ends, or there can be one centrally mounted revolving amber light on top of the sign.

PILOT CAR INSURANCE

LAW ENFORCEMENT ESCORTS

SUPERLOAD PERMITS & STATE POLICE

A NDDOT engineer or NDHP Commander may determine an NDHP escort is required on a load movement of excessive size and/or weight.

A load movement exceeding 18' in overall width may be required to have a Highway Patrol escort as determined by the NDHP district commander. The escort fee is \$50 per hour and \$0.50 per mile.

PERMIT FINES

FINES FOR DIMENSION VIOLATIONS

Overdimensional and/or Overweight Citation: \$20 and \$100

FINES FOR WEIGHT VIOLATIONS

Overweight fines may be assessed for over axle, gross, and exterior bridge and interior bridge length violations, whichever produces the greater fine. Drivers may not shift load to avoid an overaxle citation.
